NEED A RIDE HOME?

The McClellan Park TMA provides an emergency ride home for employees who commute to McClellan Park by carpool, vanpool, mass transit, bicycle or other alternative commute mode. You can have comfort knowing that if:

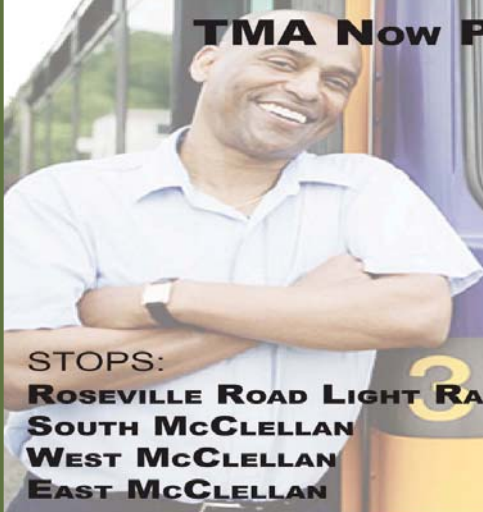
- An immediate family member has an emergency and you can't wait for your normal ride, or
- A serious problem arises at your child's school or daycare, or
- Your home is damaged by burglary or fire, or
- You are sick and can't wait for your normal ride home, or
- Your rideshare partner has an emergency and you have no way to get home, or
- Unscheduled, supervisor approved overtime prevents you from ridesharing home,

CALLING ALL REGISTERED COMMUTERS!

As a registered carpooler, vanpooler, transit rider or bicyclist with the TMA, you have signed a Commuter Benefit Agreement stating that you are receiving subsidy benefits from the TMA and that you would participate in the Annual Commute Survey held in October. Benefits may be: a) Carpool Spaces at your place of business and Emergency Ride Home, b) 50% subsidy for a monthly Bus and Light Rail pass and Emergency Ride Home, c) \$65 a rider subsidy in a Vanpool and Emergency Ride Home; or d) Bike Locker rental for your bicycle at your place of business and Emergency Ride Home.

If you did not complete the Annual Commute Survey in October, the TMA will be contacting you within the next month to evaluate continued benefits. A summary report of the Annual Survey will be reported to the County and without a survey from all TMA participants, the TMA cannot accurately report the growth and benefit of the program.
