RT BOARD APPROVES FARE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JAN 1

The Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) approved increases to bus, light rail and complimentary Paratransit fares effective Thursday, January 1, 2009 in response to the loss in state funds for transportation for the fiscal year 2009. Monthly passes will be increased by \$15. A monthly pass of \$100 will continue to be subsidized by the TMA if you are an employee of a leased tenant of McClellan Business Park at 50%.
