



BIKE SUBSIDY PROGRAM

APPLICATION AND USAGE AGREEMENT

POLICY AND PROCEDURE STATEMENT

This program is designed to promote bicycle commuting. The McClellan Park TMA has limited funding to subsidize new commuter bicycles for a \$390 subsidy toward a bicycle priced at \$500 or more. As a condition of funding, recipients will track commute usage and document the results.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

1. "Employee" is defined as any person paid to work a minimum of 20 hours per week that has been employed by the McClellan Park TMA member company for a minimum of 3 months.
2. Approved participants must visit the TMA office to view a 30 minute Smart Cycling video and cycle to work at least ten days during May is Bike Month. If your subsidy is awarded after May then you must log ten bike to work days at sacregion511.org for one month. Failure to log ten bike to work days in either database may make you ineligible for future programs and promotions.
3. Incentives are limited to one per individual in any one calendar year.
4. Bicycles must be new; no two-party agreements will be reimbursed.
5. This subsidy cannot be combined with any other incentives.
6. Applicants will visit the Patriot Bike Shop at 7441 Madison Avenue, Citrus Heights and obtain a quote for the bicycle they intend to purchase.
7. If selected to receive a subsidy, the applicant may purchase a different bicycle than the one submitted for the quote. The subsidy will be \$390 toward a bicycle priced at \$500 or more and cannot be more than what was budgeted based on the quote that was submitted.

TO APPLY FOR THE BICYCLE SUBSIDY

1. Visit the Patriot Bicycles Shop for a quote.
2. Complete the Bike Subsidy Program Application.
3. Return the completed, signed application and quote to the McClellan Park TMA by emailing brager@mcclellanparktma.org.
4. If your application is selected, you will have 30 days from the day of notification to visit the TMA office to view a 30 minute Smart Cycling video and return a receipt.
5. If selected to receive a subsidy, you may purchase a different bicycle than the one submitted for the quote. The subsidy will be \$390 toward the purchase of a bicycle priced at \$500 or more.
